Cllrs. discussed how to proceed with the appointment of a successor Clerk.

RESOLVED that Cllrs. Brazier and Mrs. Jeffrey meet with the Clerk to discuss an advertisement and job description for the post, giving consideration to the possibility of decreasing the Clerk's hours to 20 per week and appointing an Assistant Clerk for 15 hours per week.

The Minutes of the Special meeting held on 24 November 1999 were taken as read, confirmed and signed as a true copy.

### 2. Matters Arising from the Minutes.

### Page 1 - Additional Items of Expenditure

Cllrs. discussed the suggestion of purchasing a trailer for the Common Ranger to use to remove fly tipping from the Common.

RESOLVED not to purchase a trailer in the 2000/01 financial year.

Cllrs. discussed the purchase of play equipment for the Smallford Playing Field site. RESOLVED to reduce the budget from £10,000 to £9,000 for the purchase and installation of play equipment at the Smallford Playing Field site.

Cllrs. considered the revised quotations received for the work required to widen the car park at the High Street Recreation Ground.

RESOLVED to accept the quotation by Nedburn Properties and enquire whether they would be able to carry out the work during a school holiday when the car park was least used.

The Clerk reported that the CDC had advised the Council to contact the District Valuer for an estimate of the ratable value of the new Parish Office, which could be up to £1,000 per annum.



## 3. Final Budget Requirements for 2000/01 Financial Year.

Cllrs. considered all items of expenditure and income and made the following adjustments to the figures:

Increase of £340 for burglar alarm at Parish Office.

Decrease of £300 for car mileage.

Decrease of £412 for HSRG pitch fees.

Decrease of £2000 for widening of HSRG car park.

Decrease of £500 for Sleapshyde Pond.

Decrease of £1000 for Smallford Playing Field.

Increase of £635.51 for Village Hall rates.

Increase of £1658 for Building Fund.

Decrease of £6 for BKVC trees.

Increase of 49p for Chairman's Allowance.

Decrease of £50 for Cub & Youth Football school pitch fees.

Increase of 50p for Warren Pitch fees.

After further discussion

RESOLVED to precept the City & District Council for £79,077 which would mean a Parish Precept of £43 for each Band D equivalent property in the parish.
